Come prepared with:

- Swimsuit We will be in the water!
- Base Layer/Sun shirt/Rashguard (next to skin): think long underwear, great for warmth and sun protection. A shorty wetsuit is also nice, but not mandatory.
- Mid Layer (insulating): fleece sweater or vest.
- Outer Layer (rain coat): wind/rain proof.
- Head: snug fitting hat or visor, sunglasses with retaining strap.
- Feet: we sail barefoot on the beach.
- Sunscreen Crucial!
- Beach Towel
- Drinks. Please send your camper with a water bottle. We can refill as needed.
- Snacks. Be sure to pack a snack in addition to eating a solid breakfast.
