## SSA Boat Checklist

### Pre-board

- Check Weather forecast, VHF weather channel #2 or #5
- Check Current Conditions – [Windbag Weather](#)
- Waivers signed for you and all passengers on your boat
- Person on shore notified of your sailing plan – time out, destination, time expected in

### Safety/Personal Equipment

- VHF Radio or waterproof cell phone on board
- Each person who will be on board is wearing a Life Jacket
- Personal equipment – Hat, water, sun screen
- Paddle in the boat

### Boat Condition

#### Rig (mast, boom, shrouds, stays)

- Mast step (base) secure
- Port & Starboard shroud pins and circle clips in place
- Fore stay pins and circle clips in place
- Mast & Boom Connection (Gooseneck) secure
- Cleats for halyards tight, serviceable

#### Hull (Deck, rudder, drain plug)

- Hull & Deck free from damage, scrapes, loose trim
- Drain plug in place
- Rudder pintels locked in place
- Tiller in good shape, rudder turns freely
- Deck fittings & cleats all secure, serviceable

### Sails

- Main Sail clean, free from tears,
- Main Sail head board and bolt ropes in good condition
- Jib Sail clean, free from tears
- Jib hanks all secure

### Lines

- Main sheet free of knots, frayed spots
- Main Halyard free of kinks, frayed spots
- Jib sheet secured to jib, figure 8 knots in ends
- Jib Halyard free of kinks, frayed spots
