- 6:30 PM – First warning signal
- Race committee is responsible for starting the last race such that all boats are in the Windbag before dark

Courses: Courses will be determined by that evenings race committee

Notice of Race

SSA PHRF Kick off

Come kick the summer off with a combined buoy race with PHRF and our one design fleet. Each fleet will have their own start and finish. Lets shake the rust of everyone!

Date: June 4, 2022

Location: North end of Lake Pend Oreille, off city beach area and outside the no wake zone

Classes:

- PHRF
- One design J24 and Capri 25

Rules: This race will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024* unless otherwise specified.

Schedule:

- 12:00 PM – Skippers meeting at Fred’s deck
- 1:00 PM – First warning signal
- J24 first start
- Capri 25 second start
- PHRF third start (depending on attendance starts 2 and 3 may be combined)
- No starts after 4:00

Courses: Standard windward leeward, but may also include a gybe mark and/or leeward gate. As we are sailing with the OD classes all finishes will be standard upwind finish.

Notice of Race

SSA PHRF Long Distance Race

This race is an SSA classic. Starting from just outside the Windbag you will make your way to a single mark just north of the train trestle, then from there navigate your way all the way to the Fisherman's Islands, around the Islands, and then sail your way all the way back to the start finish line. Bring plenty of snacks and refreshments for this race.

Date: June 11, 2022

Location: North end of Lake Pend Oreille, off city beach area and outside the no wake zone, out to Fisherman's Islands.

Classes:

- PHRF

Rules: This race will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024* unless otherwise specified.

Schedule:

- 12:00 PM – Skippers meeting at Fred's deck
- 1:00 PM start
- This is a self-timed race. Honor's system is in place.
- No finishes after sunset

Courses: Keeping in mind that this is a self-timed race, once the starting horn has sounded everyone is responsible for their own time. From just east of the Windbag there will be a gate that services as the start finish line. Following the start, there will be buoy placed to the north of the train trestle that acts as a "gybe" mark. Once sailors have rounded the mark the next objective is to sail around Fisherman's, note that you **CAN NOT** sail between the islands. You must go around both. **WARNING** the northeast side of the northern island has shallow waters. It is recommended that you sail between the island and the no wake buoy that is stationed. That water is safe and navigable. Once you have rounded both island, it is a race to the finish line. Upon crossing the finish line sailors are to record their total race time for scoring.

SSA PHRF “Race” to Bottle Bay

A new addition to the schedule this year. This event will involve sailors casually (or not so casually) making their way from with Windbag, around Contest point, down the shore line around Sour Dough Point, then all the to the Bottle Bay Marina. There, you can tie up and head into Loaf and Ladle to grab a bite to eat and a cold drink before making your way back to Windbag. Note that this is untimed event, strictly a social event.

Location: North end of Lake Pend Oreille, off city beach area and outside the no wake zone out to the waters of Bottle Bay.

Classes:

Rules: This “race” will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024* unless otherwise specified.

Schedule:

- 12:00 PM – Skippers meeting at Fred’s deck
- 1:00 PM start
- “Race” to Bottle Bay Marina
- Socialize, enjoy cocktails, lunch/dinner, tell cool stories
- “Race” back to Windbag

Courses: As this is more geared toward being a social/cruising event, there is no strict course to follow. There will be no official start finish line either, however the no wake buoys can be used as impromptu start finish line. Keep in mind that the wind can be fluky once past contest point, plan your routes accordingly.

Courses: Standard two lap windward leeward, Standard Olympic course. Downwind start, leeward windward, downwind finish

Poker Run

The Poker Run is a fun and exciting race of adventure, sailing skills, and a little bit of luck. In this event it's not always about being the fastest, there is also a lot of luck involved. Any boat could win!

Date: August 6, 2022

Location: North end of Lake Pend Oreille, off city beach area and outside the no wake zone

Classes:

- PHRF

Rules: This race will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024* unless otherwise specified.

Schedule:

- 12:00 PM – Skippers meeting at Fred's deck
- 1:00 PM – First warning signal
- No starts after 4:00

Courses: There is nothing standard about this race. The "game" works like this. There will be a standard upwind start, after crossing the starting there will be four buoys placed out in the water roughly following the four cardinal directions. Boats must visit each of these buoys in any order they choose, picking up their boats assigned cards. However, there is a kicker. Each boat must pick up their assigned cards, which have been placed at marks randomly, IN ORDER. For example, if the first mark you sail to has your boats second, third, or fourth card, you must leave it and go sail to another mark until you find your first card. Once you have gathered your cards in order you must sail back through the finish line in an up wind fashion.

Helen Gloor Moonlight Race

This is another SSA classic. Named in the memory of Helen Gloor, this fun social event paired with a unique race experience is the highlight of many sailor's summer. Sailors will make their way out to Fisherman's Islands where they will raft up and enjoy a potluck style cook out. Following the raft up, right around sunset, sailors will then begin the self-timed race back to the windbag in the dark. Remember to check your batteries everyone as you will need to have your Navigation lights on!

Date: August 13, 2022

Location: North end of Lake Pend Oreille, off city beach area and outside the no wake zone to the North side of the Fisherman's Islands.

Classes:

- PHRF

Rules: This race will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024* unless otherwise specified.

Schedule:

- 5:00 PM Raft up social at Fisherman's Island – No skippers meeting
- Race begins right around sunset

Courses: Upon an unconventional "ready, set, go!" start out at the islands, sailors will have to navigate their way back to the Windbag Marina. There will be lights fixed to two of the no wake buoys that represent the finish line. Sailors are responsible for keeping their own time. Remember to get your running lights in working order, as this race occurs in the late evening and has the potential to go well into the night. There are no marks sailors must round, just a straight shot home from the islands.

Wind Sprints

The Winds Sprints are intended to get sailors practice on the starting line just before Spud cup. Courses are set intentionally short in order to maximize the number of races and there for starts. This is a great practice event to get your timing on the line dialed in, as well as your practice your mark rounding's and spinnaker sets.

Location: North end of Lake Pend Oreille, off city beach area and outside the no wake zone.

Classes:

- PHRF
- J24 One Design
- Capri 25 One Design

Rules: This race will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024* unless otherwise specified.

Schedule:

- 12:00 skippers meeting
- 1:00 first horn
- One design boats start first
- PHRF fleet will start after OD
- No starts after 4:00

Courses: One lap standard windward leeward. Up wind finishes. Course is set intentionally shorter.

Courses: Standard windward leeward, but may also include a gybe mark and/or leeward gate. As we are sailing with the OD classes all finishes will be standard upwind finish.

Schedule:

- 9:00 AM – Skippers meeting at Fred's deck
- 9:30 AM – Begin voyage over to Hope
- 7:00 PM – End of event. Sailors must make their own arrangements for accommodations or trip home

Courses: There is no intended course for this event. It is a Social cruise amongst friends to build comradery. Bring all appropriate gear and equipment necessary.
