

Sandpoint Sailing Association Covid-19 Protocol

1. Limit close interaction between crews and race committee
 - a. Skipper's meeting information will be distributed electronically and via radio
 - i. Electronic via email and/or text to current SSA members.
 - ii. Radio via VHF channel #72
 - b. Skipper's meeting information will include:
 - i. Time of the first horn of the start sequence.
 - ii. Number and type of fleets (typically one or two).
 - iii. Course to be sailed.
 - c. No SSA Sponsored gatherings will be held a Fred's Deck.
 - d. Skippers are responsible for determining who can be crew on their sailboat.
 - e. Race Committee shall be limited to the number of committee members that can maintain social distancing.
2. Provide adequate sanitation for Sailors and Race Committee
 - a. The committee boat and SSA owned boats will be equipped with the following:
 - i. Spray bottle of disinfectant spray
 - ii. Paper towels
 - b. It will be the responsibility of each sailor using SSA equipment or the Committee Boat to sanitize the boat prior to their use and to dispose of used cleaning supplies properly.
3. SSA will strive to comply with current State of Idaho guidelines for safe practices.
4. Sailors and Race Committee should not participate if they have any of the following:
 - a. Fever greater than 100°
 - b. Cough and/or shortness of breath
 - c. Chills
 - d. Repeated shaking with chills
 - e. Unexplained muscle pain (not exercise induced)
 - f. Headache
 - g. Sore Throat
 - h. Loss of taste or smell
